

**“Onside”** is a football coaching project for children; it is organised by Birmingham City Mission (BCM) in partnership with Faith & Football. Onside operates in line with Birmingham City Mission’s child protection policy, which includes provision for assessing the suitability of leaders by conducting checks with the Criminal Records Bureau.

The club meets at Woodview Community Centre on **Mondays** during the summer term time.

There are 2 sessions. Each session comprises level 2 Football Association Coaching and a short Bible story or talk relating to Christian values. Children who arrive after the session has started are not allowed to attend that week.

**Respect other people’s property.**
